Often family members from out of town are stretched for time and may find it difficult to know where to turn for help in a strange city.

Whether you are bringing items to our thrift store, or asking for a home assessment, our staff and volunteers will remain sensitive to your situation. All interactions occur in an atmosphere of care and respect allowing the transition to be completed with as much dignity and as little stress as possible.

A representative is available to come to your home to assess the situation, and ensure your needs are met. In many cases we can handle everything that you do not wish to keep.
